DIRECTIONS TO TEST:

GPS use 300 Knightsbridge Pkwy, Lincolnshire, IL

From north or south via I-94 (Tri-State Tollway): Exit at Rt. 22 (Half Day Road); go west on Route 22 to Milwaukee Road (Route 21); turn left onto Milwaukee Road to second stoplight (Knightsbridge Parkway); turn right onto Knightsbridge Parkway (into Lincolnshire Corporate Center); proceed 1/8 mile to parking lot of baseball diamond on left.

EXHIBITORS PLEASE NOTE:

In accordance with AKC Regulations, entries in this tracking test will be accepted up until the official closing date and time, even though the advertised limit has been reached.

Entries must be made on an Official American Kennel Club Entry Form and, for dogs that have not passed an AKC tracking test, **must include an original certification signed by an AKC Tracking Judge.**

Dogs not holding any AKC tracking title will be given priority for entry into this test.

A **drawing for placement** within the test will be held at the home of the test secretary on Thursday, March 15, 2018 at 7 P.M. The drawing is open to the public.

Due to Space Limitations the TD test shall be limited to three entries. The AKC **Combined Tests Exchange Policy** will be in effect for these tests if the TD portion does not fill. A worker draw will be used in accordance with the parameters set forth in Ch. 1, Sec. 17d, as amended (effective January 1, 2015) of the AKC Tracking Regulations and as determined by the Board of the Rand Park Dog Training Club and published in the January, 2010 Meeting minutes and Newsletter. A separate **worker draw** will be used and one (1) track will be set aside for each test if three or more entries are received for that test. For the TDU test, two (2) tracks will be set aside if there are between 6-8 entries. If the TDU number increases to nine or more entries, three (3) TDU tracks will be set aside for workers. Immediately after the worker draw another draw will be conducted to determine the remaining entries.

These drawings, conducted by the test secretary, shall be completely at random from among the entries received. When the advertised limit has been drawn, all remaining entries shall be similarly drawn and assigned a position on the alternate lists, subject to the same preferences set forth above.

The test secretary will attempt to notify all entries of the result of the drawings within 48 hours by telephone or email. Alternates have the option to accept or decline being placed on the alternate list. Those who opt to decline shall have their entry fees returned upon written notification to the test secretary of their intention to withdraw from the alternate list.

In the event an accepted entry cancels after the closing of entries, the test secretary shall contact alternates in the order of their placement on the alternate list. Upon such notification, alternates shall have the option to accept or decline the opportunity to participate in the test. No entry fee will be refunded except that of an alternate who does not participate in the test. Exception: In the event that an accepted entry withdraws from the test and an alternate replaces that entry, refund will be made to the withdrawn entry. In the event an accepted entry is absent on the day of the test, it shall be the responsibility of the test secretary to determine if alternates are present, and to determine, by their position on the alternate list, which of the alternates will participate. Rand Park Dog Training Club reserves the right to cancel the test due to extreme weather conditions.

Bitches in season will be permitted to run and will be assigned to the last track(s).

Dogs must be on lead at all times in any area of the tracking site.

The assignment of dogs to the tracks is the responsibility of the judges.
